Greetings!

How is school going for your kiddos now that they have been going for about a month? I think almost all of your kids are going to school in person. Hopefully that will continue throughout this whole school year.



I miss your kids! It has been 5 1/2 months since we have met for children's church. Wow! Have you been able to talk about living like Jesus during these months away from kids' church? I hope you can have your own church or your devotions with your child.

Pastor Michael has given us permission to resume Children's Church!!! Would you be comfortable with your child coming to children's church if we still wore our masks, sat at benches at a distance, and ate individually packaged snacks?

If you would prefer to keep your child with you during the service, I can provide your child with some quiet activities to do. I understand it has to be difficult to sit still through a service and a sermon that they don't understand.

High Point is our children's group for Kindergartners through 3rd graders that meets on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-7:30. Crew 4-5-6 is our group for older kids (4th, 5th, and 6th graders) that meets at the same time. We play outside until it is time to begin our lessons in different rooms. Children and adults may wear masks, but are not required to. We do our best to social distance during games, activities, and lessons. I am trying to improve children's ministry on Wednesday evenings - is there something that you wish we did differently to make it more convenient to bring your child to High Point and Crew 4-5-6?
