What if you removed the entire bush, from its roots, then you wouldn't get stuck by the thorns. The question is . . . are you solving problems at the branch level or the root level? I've been there on that one!

My point is, are we looking for a quick fix, or a permanent solution? What's your strategy for next year? How are you going to grow closer to God? Do you have a plan? How can I help you to better experience His grace, mercy, peace, power, love and more? Remember the Christmas promise from Paul in Galatians 4 - -

4 But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born

under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons and daughters. 6 And because you are His children, God has sent the

Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" 7 So you are no longer a slave,

but sons and daughters, and if a son and daughter, then an heir through God. - Galatians 4:4-7

How glorious that when you say YES to Jesus, you become a child in God's family and you have full inheritance rights! Thank you, Jesus!!



Step-by-Step instructions to download and access the app:

- 1. With your smart phone touch the App Store icon for your type of phone (Apple Store or Google Play) then search for: '**Universal Church Directory**'
- 2. The App is called *myUCD*. Click on the "Get" or "Install" button
- 3. When the app has finished installing, click "Open"
- 4. Enter the following Unique Identifier: **fpeCwEXNH** (this is case sensitive)
- 5. Click on the gray "Download My Church Directory" button (there may be a delay)
- 6. Begin using the church app features such as:
 - Watch Services
 - Email the church
 - Call the church
 - View Announcements and Events
 - View the church calendar
 - Give Online
 - Access YouVersion Bible
 - View the church directory
 - Visit the church website
 - Visit the church's Facebook page

To access the directory on a desktop computer:

- 1. Go to directory.ucdir.com
- 2. Enter the following Unique Identifier: **fpeCwEXNH** (this is case sensitive)
- 3. Hit "Go"
- 4. Prompts will appear to create your own Username and Password
- 5. Click on "Create Account"
