Time to Offer Thanksgiving

In Psalm 107:1-2, we read ---- 1 Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; his love endures forever. 2 Let the redeemed of the Lord tell their story - those He redeemed from the hand of the foe."


On Tuesday, November 5 at 11:30am, we will leave from the church to go out to eat. All are welcome to join us!

A reminder that the Watchmen will be praying at the Alexandria Jr/Sr High School at 3:15pm on the first Thursday of each month


